

In-person Worship Guidelines

In order to comply with the Governor's Recommendations and to provide a safe environment for every person attending worship, the following practices and procedures will be in effect:

- Individuals with a fever, cough, or signs of illness, symptoms of Covid19 or who have had close contact with someone that has tested positive for Covid19 are requested to worship remotely by Internet, TV or radio until you are cleared.
- Individuals with underlying health issues or compromised immunity are encouraged to remain at home and worship remotely until it is safe to be in crowds.
- Upon arrival, enter at the covered entrance by the office and after worship you will exit at the steeple entrance to avoid crowded hallways.
- We will not have child care, children's or youth services or Sunday school.
- Everyone will be seated by an usher in order to maintain safe distancing and to maximize our limited capacity. It will not be possible to sit according to personal preference.
- Due to increased susceptibility to Covid19, some sections will be designated as Senior Adult seating.
- The congregation will be dismissed by ushers in an orderly fashion following worship.
- Everyone is expected to wear a face covering while in the building in order to protect those around you.
- Containers for your offering will be in place. No plates will be passed.
